How healthy is your construction business?

Every year more working days are lost to **work related illnesses** compared to injuries. Last year, an estimated **1.7** million days were lost to ill health, costing the construction industry **£0.4bn**.

Reductions in occupational disease in construction have also not kept pace with improvements in safety management. It is estimated that approximately **100 times** as many people lose their lives from ill-health caused by working in construction compared to fatal accidents.

So it is not surprising that the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) has made 'Occupational Health' a focal point, with site blitzes expected to continue. It also explains why the HSE is encouraging companies to work in partnership with organisations like the **Building Safety Group (BSG)** to help improve Occupational Health in the workplace.
