BSG Reporting Suite

Reports can be run across any selected time period and can be used to analyse over 50 different types of non-compliance and RIDDOR classified accident occurrences





Accidents by cause




BSG's reporting suite is accessed via an online portal which is available 24-7-365.

Report information is constantly kept up to date, usually within the hour as new non-compliances and accidents are recorded.

BSG Reporting Usage

BSG's reports are used by over 600 companies located throughout the UK to;

- Identify non-compliance and accident trends
- Monitor and review site performance
- Single out poorly performing construction sites for improvement
- View company accidents as classified by RIDDOR
- Set Health and Safety KPIs
- Ensure regulatory compliance with RIDDOR reporting
- Quickly identify risks that need to be removed or reduced
- Implement and manage Corrective and Preventative Action tracking (CAPA)
- Notify and escalate incidents to the appropriate management level based on risk severity



Organisations can also use the information provided to build a **historical** and shared **knowledge base** throughout the business. This allows companies to **benchmark** sites with the lowest scores, which can be used as the basis for setting nominal targets to achieve **best practice** in Health and Safety.

Site Managers can search for site risk criteria to establish **patterns** and underlying **causes** of incidents and accidents.

How reporting information is collected by BSG

Non-compliance and accident data is collected through site inspections conducted by BSG's expert and highly qualified Safety Advisors. Over 20,000 inspections are conducted by BSG every year.

All BSG site visits generate an electronic **Site Inspection Report** which is transmitted to companies' offices. Each report provides a **quantified snapshot** of the inspected site's health and safety performance as well as a **Site Action Plan**, which identifies and priorities any **non compliances** for the Site Manager to address.

Data from individual site reports is consolidated so that companies can combine and view non-compliance or accident occurrences over any period of time, by using **BSG's reporting suite**.
