Loading Shovel Training

Loading Shovel (Bucket Loader) training would be delivered to you on your own site, you would need to supply the loader, equipment and area to conduct training. Training can be delivered in a working environment. The trainer will incorporate practical tasks, meaning candidates are able to undertake jobs they are required to complete in their normal working day.

This course qualifies you to operate loading shovels within the category of shovel for which you receive training. Operate loading shovels on any site in the UK with permission of the person responsible for site H & S. Use any attachment for which you receive training. It does not qualify you to instruct others in the use of a loading shovel or supervise anyone who has not received formal training and qualification in the use of a loading shovel.

Candidates per course

Maximum of 3 delegates per day.

Course duration

Course duration is dependent upon delegate numbers and experience. There is no minimum number of delegates required for training to commence.

Novice	Less than 6 months operating experience 3 day course (1 delegate: 1 Instructor) 4 day course (2 delegates: 1 Instructor) 5 day course (3 delegates: 1 Instructor)
Experienced	More than 6 months regular operating experience 2 day course (1-2 delegates: 1 Instructor) 3 day course (3 delegates: 1 Instructor)
Refresher	Successfully completed formal training in the last 5 years 1 day course (1-3 delegates: 1 Instructor)



Minimum PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Safety Footwear All delegates must wear safety footwear for the duration of practical training. Delegates will not be allowed to participate in training without safety footwear.

Hi vis coat, vest & hard hat Must be available for the practical training and assessment.

Equipment requirements

The client is responsible for supplying all equipment & PPE.

Loading shovel In good serviceable condition. Manufacturers' instructions should be made available for training.

Loads/materials A supply of realistic loads appropriate to the training being given. Training will simulate a working environment. Without a good selection of loads to handle, training might fall short of expected standards.

Practical Training Area While training is in progress, access to this area should be restricted to the instructor and trainees. Normal work tasks potentially may be incorporated at a later stage.

Office/ Classroom/ Cabin A well-lit and suitable heated closed-door environment to conduct theory training. Tables and chairs to accommodate all delegates and the trainer assessor, this must include writing space for all delegates. A screen or projector is desirable but not essential.

Exclusive use of this facility is required for between 60-120 minutes on the morning of each training day.
