This course covers the practical skills needed by a first aider in the modern workplace. The course will give you the confidence and knowledge to deal with first aid emergencies. The course should be refreshed every 3 years with the 2 day requalification course.

What will you learn?

The course will give delegates the knowledge to qualify as a First Aider in the workplace and to efficiently manage any event at work where a person requires medical attention.

- Recognise both trauma and medical emergencies.
- Provide basic First Aid Treatment for both conscious and unconscious casualties.
- Take sufficient steps to provide professional medical treatment.
- State and use the contents of a First Aid Kit
- Safely and efficiently manage any incident where somebody requires medical attention at work.
