Industrial Forklift Truck Operator Training

Forklift training can be delivered to you on your own site; you would need to supply the truck and area to conduct training.

Lift truck training needs to be carried out off the job. This means that the instructor and trainees, together with the lift truck and loads, should be wholly concerned with training, kept away from normal commercial operations, and not be diverted to other activities while training is in progress. This is a specific requirement of the HSE as outlined in section 36 of the ACOP L117.

Course duration

Course duration is dependent upon delegate numbers and experience. There is no minimum number of delegates required for training to commence.



Novice	Less than 6 months operating experience 3 day course (1 delegate: 1 Instructor) 4 day course (2 delegates: 1 Instructor) 5 day course (3 delegates: 1 Instructor)
Experienced	More than 6 months regular operating experience 2 day course (1-2 delegates: 1 Instructor) 3 day course (3 delegates: 1 Instructor)
Refresher	Successfully completed formal training in the last 5 years 1 day course (1-3 delegates: 1 Instructor)
Conversion	From one truck type to another 2 day course (1-3 delegates: 1 Instructor)

Minimum PPE (personal protective equipment)

Safety Footwear All delegates must wear safety footwear for the duration of practical training. Delegates will not be allowed to participate in training without safety footwear.

Hi vis coat, vest & hard hat Must be available for the practical training and assessment.

Equipment Requirements

The client is responsible for supplying all equipment & PPE.

Lift Truck In good, serviceable condition.

Loads/ Materials A supply of realistic loads appropriate to the training being given, such as loaded and unloaded pallets, bags, sacks, bales, drums and bulk materials is necessary to make training realistic. Similarly, there should be appropriate facilities for simulating stacking at a minimum height of 3 metres.

Practical Training Area For all vehicle-based operator/instructor training, a suitable manoeuvring area should be provided. As a rule of thumb, this area should be large enough that the vehicle used for training can comfortably perform a figure of 8 manoeuvre at a minimum.

Office/ classroom/ cabin A well-lit and suitably heated closed-door environment to conduct theory training. Tables and chairs to accommodate all learners and the trainer assessor, this must include writing space for all learners. A screen or projector is desirable but not essential.

Exclusive use of this facility is required for between 60-120 minutes on the morning of each training day.
