Where possible ALL open e	excavations / groundworks are to be backfilled prior to shutdown			
If unable to backfill – area is to have suitable barriers / edge protection in place				
Shallow excavations are to be covered where possible / suitable battered				
Deep excavations are to be	suitably shored – and inspected prior to site closure

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Fuels / oils & flammables	✓
Any diesel left on site must be contained within a secured, water tight, rigid bund (100%> of volume stored)	
Drums must be secure / stable to that cannot fall over	
Flammable substances are to be removed from site (Petrol, LPG, Butane, Oxyacetylene etc.)	
Filling appliances / hoses are to be securely stored to prevent unauthorised use	
Services	✓
Water systems are to be drained down to prevent damage through burst pipes	
Temporary supplies to site is to be isolated at the stopcock	
ALL mains supplies (Gas & Electric) is to be turned off at meter – except where lighting / illumination is essential	
Miscellaneous	✓
ALL small tools are to be secured in a lockable container / chest	
A copy of the Public Notice is to be correctly displayed at the site entrance
