BSG Awards Keynote Presentation, Emma Evans

- Position on enforcement and consequences for noncompliance
- Implications for Principal Contractors and other Contractors who may have design input into High Rise Building (HRB) projects
- Impact the BSA has had on existing legislation; and
- What impact does the BSA have for those working outside of Higher Risk Buildings (HRBs) regime, and does it still impact on other / all buildings.

The <u>Black Country Living Museum</u> (BCLM) is an award-winning open air museum that tells the story of one of the very first industrialised landscapes in Britain.

The idea to create an open-air, living museum that told the story of the Black Country all started in the late 1960s. This was a period of rapid change for the region that saw the closure of the last working coal mine. Manufacturing dwindled and many canals lay deserted, railways began to close and the Black Country as many knew changed irrevocably.

Set across 26 acres, **BSG members** will be given the opportunity to explore carefully reconstructed shops, houses and industrial areas that represent the Black Country's story. You'll learn how steam power, human ingenuity and an increasingly interconnected world transformed this region into a manufacturing powerhouse.

You'll meet historic characters who'll tell you stories of what it was really like to live and work during this revolutionary period of history. As you walk around, you'll discover the museum's collections, which were 'Designated' by Arts Council England in 2012, recognising their quality and national significance.

Most importantly, you'll see history brought to life before your eyes – hear the clang of hammers, smell the smoke billowing from red brick chimneys and maybe even taste the best fish and chips in the Black Country!
