Slinger Signaller / Banksman Training

This course qualifies you to attach and sling loads of any weight and size with any kind of lifting equipment. Signal the operators of lifting equipment using recognised signals and procedures. Operate as a Slinger Banksman on any site in the UK with permission of the person responsible for site H&S. It does not qualify you to act as an appointed person for slinging operations or instruct/supervise others who have not received formal training as a Slinger Signaller.

Candidates per course

1-2 day course, depending on experience. Maximum of 3 delegates per day.

Minimum PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Safety Footwear

All delegates must wear safety footwear for the duration of practical training. Delegates will not be allowed to participate in training without safety footwear.

High vis coat, hard hat

Must be available for the practical training and assessment.



Equipment requirements

The client is responsible for supplying all equipment & PPE.

Lifting Equipment

In good, serviceable condition.

Lifting Tackle

Sufficient that a load can be attached and lifted. Examples include Webbing Slings, Chain Slings, Round Slings, Wire Rope Slings, Shackles, Eye Bolts, Lifting Frames/Spreader Beams etc.

Available on request, all lifting tackle must have a current and in date certificate of inspection. This inspection should adhere to the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER).

Loads/ Materials

A supply of realistic loads appropriate to the training being given. Training will simulate a working environment. Without a good selection of loads to handle, training might fall short of expected standards.

Practical Training area

While training is in progress, access to this area should be restricted to the instructor and trainees. Where practicable, training areas should be sheltered from adverse weather conditions.

Office/ Classroom/ Cabin

A Well-lit and suitably heated closed-door environment to conduct theory training. Tables and chairs to accommodate all learners and the trainer assessor, this must include writing space for all learners. A screen and projector are desirable but not essential.
